SCHOOL UNIFORM

Following feedback from parents at parent evening we can now supply cardigans with the school logo. These are available at a **price of £9**. We are also able to get stronger P.E./swimming bags for £4. Another request was for waterproof jacket and trousers that could be left at school: this is fully waterproof and windproof with a zip away hood and deep pockets in jacket and trousers. It has snap close adjustable cuffs, elasticated waist and adjustable snap close ankles. The suit comes in its own zip closing carry bag and costs £13.
