CHILDREN'S UNIVERSITY

The Children's University have changed the way they are awarding certificates, putting the emphasis on the quality of the activity undertaken as credits instead of the number of hours spent on an activity. They now require evidence of non-validated learning experiences and a brief description of what has been done and learnt.
